

The 92 boys also competed in the 2009 Southern Premiere League playing the best teams from Texas and Oklahoma. While weather forced some delays

and cancelations working in the team's favor, the squad completed the season as the 3rd ranked team in the Southern Premiere League. The SPL West includes the top 12 teams in the West Division of the Southern United States. Interestingly, OFC 92, who WSA outdid in OPL play claimed the SPL championship, and Celtic 92 claimed runner-up. "The strength of our age division is evident in the standings, the top 3 from Oklahoma," reports Bush.
